TOUR DESCRIPTION

The Nordic walking route starts in Mittelberg and passes the valley station of the Walmendingerhornbahn along Moosstraße and the Stützweg to the beautifully situated Mittelberg district of Stütze. Already on this section, there is a great panoramic view towards the Wilden and Gemsteltal. Along the scenic hillside location, the route alternates over meadows and through forest sections through the two hamlets Erlenboden and Alpenwald. Further on the Baader Höhenweg down to Baad, the smallest and highest village in the Kleinwalsertal. From Baad, which lies at the foot of the Widderstein, it goes onto the walking path on the Breitach: the Breitachweg. This leads along the cool Breitach into Gemstelboden. From there, over the bridge into the Mittelberg district of Bödmen and up via the Jörihalde back to the center of Mittelberg.






